Remember: AR reading is not just about points—it's also about challenging one's self on the level of complexity of the books!

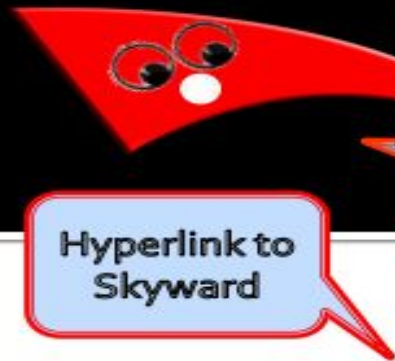
