


















## Midway Village Museum




Generics and substitutions are completely fine.

else's.






THEME NARRATING THE UNKNOWN

6th grade Math uses Pearson Realize instead of Eureka




Students will use the link on the nine-dot Google waffle to access their math program (along with workbooks) "Easybridge'







Remember: AR reading is not just about points—it's also about challenging one's self on the level of complexity of the books!


