Reading Strategy #2: Look at the pictures.



Looking at pictures gives children extra assurance before they guess at a word. Pictures helps children understand what they are reading. For example, if the unknown word is *picnic* and the picture shows a family sitting on a blanket with food, then children can use that information to think of words that might relate to picnics that start with a "p."

VISUAL CLUE

SAY:

"What would you expect to see if you see a picture of _____?"

"Can you find the word that matches the picture?"

"Frame the word that matches the picture."

MEANING CLUE

SAY:

"Look at the picture."

"What word would make sense here?"

"You said, ' _____.' Does that word make sense here?"

"Skip it and go on...What word would make sense there?"
