The first party is scheduled for **Valentine's Day**.

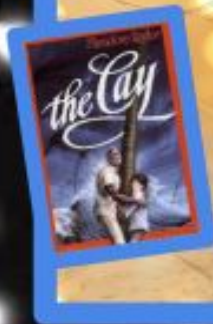
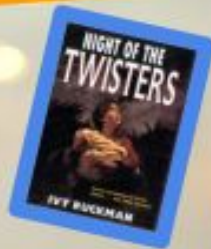
Each person on the committee will bring home a paper listing their choices along with everyone else's.
